We take our Cabernet Sauvignon very seriously at Bravante Vineyards! Our distinct blocks provide multiple varietal characteristics which help build our final blend of Cabernet each vintage, as well as bringing the very important blending component for the addition of a small amount of Malbec and Petit Verdot.

The 2018 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon is deep ruby in color with ripe notes of black cherry and cassis balanced by secondary floral notes, cedar, mint and plum. On the palate soft tones of plum & coffee bean mingle with intense but integrated tannins, showing a beautiful structure balanced with great acidity and a long finish. This structured and full bodied wine is quite complex and should age well for 10-12 years, or decant and drink now.
